PEO STRI Strategic Outlook

- I expect the work in the area of Training Aids, Devices, Simulators and Simulations (TADSS) for conventional Army forces to remain constant; we will continue to develop and field new TADSS and retire older TADSS from service. I expect growth in TADSS for combat casualty care. I expect growth in the field of Cyber Security support to Army and Joint acquisition programs – providing Red Teams for operational tests and establishing certification standards for Blue Team assistance during program development. Supporting Cyber Training will also be a growth area.
 - We must divest older TADSS in order to afford newer, better TADSS.
 - Medical Simulations for Combat Casualty Care will be a growth area. (These are not hospital medical simulations.)
 - Cyber Security Support to Joint & Army Acquisition Testing and Cyber Training Programs will be growth areas.



PEO STRI Strategic Outlook

- As the Warfighter FOCUS (WFF) contract comes to a close, it will be replaced by a group of smaller contracts. This transition from WFF to the new contracts has the PEO's complete attention. While DoD world-wide missions and the Army's annual budget may both fluctuate and drive total spending up or down, I don't anticipate the act of transitioning from one enormous contract to two large and a few small contracts to materially impact the amount of work contracted on behalf of PEO STRI.
 - Total work contracted may go up or down based on DoD mission and Army Budget.
 - Dividing the work currently done under one contract into four or five separate contracts won't itself affect net total contract values.



PEO STRI Strategic Outlook

- We are researching Other Transaction Agreements (Public Law 103-160, Section 845) and trying to determine if there are any benefits associated with using it. Examples include:
 - The DoD Ordnance Technology Consortium (DOTC) is a consortium that partners with PEO Missiles & Space.
 - The consortium for Command, Control, and Communications in Cyberspace (C5) partners with PEO C3T and PEO IEWS.
 - There is no similar consortium in support of TADSS devices to facilitate partnerships with PEO STRI.
