LETTER REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP)
AND INSTRUCTIONS TO OFFERORS
STOCII-15-OPA-0008

**Mobile Production Centers (MPCs) End of Life Replacement at the Joint
Readiness Training Center (JRTC)**

The Army Contracting Command - Orlando, on behalf of the Program Manager Training Devices Product Manager Combat Training Instrumentation Systems, will satisfy the requirements set forth herein via the issuance of a STOC II, Lot I Delivery Order (DO). Award of a Firm Fixed Price DO is planned for award on or around 31 March 2017. The resultant DO will be issued in accordance with the Performance Work Statement and Performance Specification for the MPC replacement at the JRTC provided as attachments to the enclosed Request for Proposal (RFP). All terms and conditions of the basic STOC II, Lot I contract will remain in effect for the DO. This letter and enclosure shall serve as the Government's RFP to satisfy the effort described herein.

Requirement:

The Government has a requirement to provide for the end-of-life replacement of components within the MPC at the JRTC, Fort Polk, Louisiana. An MPC is comprised of a Mobile After Action Review theatre, a Mobile Production Unit with a Retractable Power Tower with Antenna, and a Towed Generator which powers the total MPC. Additionally, interim lifecycle support for the MPC is required.

NOTE:

Attachment 5, entitled "Questions and Answers" contains questions received from potential offerors during the draft solicitation phase and Industry Day/Site Visit phase of this procurement. The Government's answers to those questions are found in the attachment. If any questions that were submitted are not included in this attachment, please notify the Government Contract Specialist immediately but no later than 17 January 2017.

Proposal Submission Instructions:

As provided by Section H.16 Delivery/Task Order Ordering Procedures of the STOC II contract, it is requested that you submit a proposal in response to the enclosures, which include the following: Specific proposal instructions and evaluation criteria as Section L, Proposal Submission Instructions and Section M Evaluation Criteria. Your proposal shall be submitted on a compact disk (2 copies) delivered to the Contract Specialist listed below. Questions concerning this RFP shall be submitted in writing (including e-mail) to the Contract Specialist listed below no later than 10:00 a.m. (ET) on 17 January 2017. Questions received after that date may not be answered.

Basis for Award:

The Government will make the award of this order to the offeror whose proposal represents the best value on the basis of lowest priced, technically acceptable (LPTA). The Government will evaluate proposals for acceptability, without consideration of tradeoffs among cost and non-cost factors. The standards for determining technical acceptability are set forth in Attachment 3, Requirements Matrix, of the enclosed RFP.

CDRL Data Rights Attachment:

Please note attachment 6 entitled “CDRL Data Rights Attachment” (“Attachment”) includes a list of each of the CDRLs included with the Delivery Order. The purpose of the Attachment is to ensure clarity regarding the rights the Government will acquire for each CDRL. The Government desires a minimum of “Government Purpose Rights” in all noncommercial technical data and noncommercial computer software and software documentation. The Offeror must complete each row of the Attachment and indicate the rights the government will acquire to each CDRL in accordance with DFARS 252.227-7013 and 252.227-7014 for all noncommercial technical data and noncommercial computer software and software documentation. The rights as indicated in the “Asserted Rights of Offeror” column will be incorporated into the final contract. The Offeror must complete each row of the Attachment.
