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# Artillery & Chemical Training (ACT) Contract



## Description/Summary of Program Requirements:

- The ACT contract is an 8(a) set-aside for providing worldwide Life Cycle Contractor Support for Air Defense, Field Artillery, and Chemical training devices
- The contractor will provide all maintenance and supply support required to maintain the training devices in an operational readiness status
- The current contract will be re-competed with an estimated contract award date of May 2012

# Warfighter FOCUS (WFF) Contract



## Description/Summary of Program Requirements:

- **Warfighter FOCUS is a single-award ID/IQ contract providing worldwide Life Cycle Contractor Support for operations, maintenance, sustainment, and instructional support of training systems used by the U.S. Army, Air Force, Marines, Navy and Multinational Coalition Forces**
- **Program executed through extensive teaming under the Warrior Training Alliance**
  - ✓ 137 total teaming partners
  - ✓ 97 small business team members

# Full Spectrum Operations (FSO)



- Upcoming FSO Rotations at the Combat Training Centers (CTCs)
    - Sep 11: JRTC
    - Oct 11: JMRC
    - Apr 12: NTC
  - Use of Instrumentation Systems at a larger magnitude than during Mission Rehearsal Exercises in a counter-insurgency scenario
  - Greater use of communication systems and infrastructure
  - Increased use of MILES supporting the rotation (Vehicle, BLUFOR, OPFOR & IPDDs)
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# *Full Spectrum Operations (FSO)*



- Less dependency on use of Forward Operating Bases (FOBs) in the CTC maneuver areas
  - Training needs:
    - OPFOR on use of MILES
    - Observer Controllers on MILES and other training enablers
    - Training Analysts on use of instrumentation training devices
    - Scenario writers for CTC FSO rotations
