## Description/Summary of Program Requirements

- A capability “toolkit” which allows tailoring of constructive training events designed to bring enhanced command and staff training at the “crawl” and “walk” phases of the Army Mission Command Training Strategy.
- Summary of requirements:
  - Supports full-spectrum operations
  - Supports Brigade and Battalion collective training (STAFFEX)
  - Supports individual leader and small group education
  - Rapid scenario generation, initialization
  - Operates on existing hardware, no more than 2 Common Hardware Platforms (CHP)
  - Easy to use; short train-up time for operators
    - New Equipment Training: eight (8) hours
    - Role player/operator training: four (4) hours
  - Reduced burden on unit personnel as role players
  - 100% government-owned software

- Initial Capability via PEO STRI Warfighter Focus
- Future Capabilities via IDIQ

- IDIQ Base 1 year with 4 option years
