

Description/Summary of Program Requirements:

- Warfighter FOCUS is a Single-Award ID/IQ contract providing worldwide Life Cycle Contractor Support for operations, maintenance, and sustainment of training systems, and instructional support for the U.S. Army, Air Force, Marines, Navy and Coalition Forces
- Program executed through extensive teaming under the Warrior Training Alliance
 - ✓ Additional business opportunities may become available as Army transitions to Unified Actions
 - ✓ 142 total teaming partners
 - ✓ 99 small business team members

Warfighter FOCUS Contract Status

- \$4.6B of \$11.2B ceiling obligated through Oct 11
- Growth has leveled off over the past three years
 - ✓ \$1.4B in FY09
 - ✓ \$1.3B in FY10
 - ✓ \$1.3B in FY11
- Based on current projections, estimate starting market research for follow-on contract in FY14
- Unknown impacts could change current projections
 - ✓ Budget
 - ✓ Contingency Operations
 - ✓ Manpower Reductions



Artillery & Chemical Training (ACT) Contract

Description/Summary of Program Requirements

- The ACT contract is an 8(a) set-aside for worldwide Life Cycle Contractor Support (LCCS) for field artillery, air defense and chemical training systems
- The contractor will provide all maintenance and supply support required to maintain the training systems in an operational readiness status
- The current contract is under re-competition. Solicitation closed on 8 Nov 11 and proposals are in source selection. Contract award estimated early 3QFY12




