- Warfighter FOCUS provides worldwide integrated training systems sustainment and training services for the Army, Air Force, Marines, Navy, SOCOM and Multinational Coalition Forces
- Program executed through extensive teaming under the Warrior Training Alliance led by Raytheon Information and Intelligence Services
 - 160 team members
 - 120 small business team members
- Transition planning for non maintenance training services is ongoing, but work will be allowed to stay on WFF as long as necessary.

Description/Summary of Program Requirements

It will provide training services integrally related to Army Program of Record (POR) TADSS maintenance.
- Customer funded training services not integrally related to POR TADSS maintenance will not be in ATMP.
