Warfighter FOCUS (WFF)

Description/Summary of Program Requirements

Warfighter FOCUS provides worldwide integrated training systems sustainment and training services for the Army, Air Force, Marines, Navy, SOCOM and Multinational Coalition Forces.

- Local and Regional contract managers concentrate manpower seamlessly maximizing efficiency
- Generates substantial efficiencies by providing cross-trained technicians within a site and across sites in various disciplines across numerous systems.
- Warrior Training Alliance led by Raytheon Information and Intelligence Services executes through extensive teaming
 - 160 team members, 120 small business team members
- Field OPS provides contract oversight
- Transition planning for non-maintenance training services ongoing
- Work will be allowed to stay on WFF as long as necessary to prevent break in training services

ACQUISITION STRATEGY

- This acquisition was competitively awarded under full and open competition to a large business
- Single Award, Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ)

- Two-year base and eight one-year options

FUNDING

- The WFF contract has a ceiling of \$11.2B over the ten-year ordering period
- \$9.8B obligated through Apr 2015
- \$1.7B subcontracted to small businesses

Army Training Maintenance Program (ATMP)

Description/Summary of Program Requirements

ATMP provides the next worldwide, integrated training systems maintenance and sustainment contract for Army Training Aids, Devices, Simulators & Simulations (TADSS), Instrumentation Systems (ISs) and Ranges (TADSS will be used to describe TADSS, ISs, and Ranges)

- Scope is Army Program of Record (POR) TADSS maintenance and training services
- Integrally related to TADSS maintenance
- Funded by the Department of the Army
- Customer-funded training services not integrally related to POR TADSS maintenance falls outside of scope
- ATMP is in Procurement Administrative Lead Time (PALT) as of 26APR2016
- Customer-funded training services move to Army Contracting Command – Orlando (ACC-Orlando)

ACQUISITION STRATEGY

- Single Award ID/IQ Contract approved by SPE July 2015
- Full and Open competition FAR 15
- Majority is FFP (90%) with limited (<10%) T&M and Cost Reimbursable requirements

PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

- Contract award 1st QTR FY2018 with a Phase-in period NTE 6 months
- Full Performance Begins 3rd QTR FY2018
- Length 7 years (base + 6 options)

FUNDING

- ATMP contract value projected to be approximately \$400M/years over the life of the contract

Training Instructor/Operator Services Support (TRIOSS)

Description/Summary of Program Requirements

Strategy revised based on Market Research results and review of the Single Award decision package:

- TRIOSS now limited to only Medical Simulation Training Centers (MSTC) and Medical Modeling & Simulation Training (MMAST) – JPMO MMS requirements
- Homestation Instrumented Training System (HITS) contracting strategy is TBD
- Intelligence and Electronic Warfare Tactical Proficiency Trainer (IEWTPT) I/O requirement likely to be a new and separate Small Business set-aside contract
- Remaining small efforts now candidates for ETSC

ACQUISITION STRATEGY

- Single Award IDIQ
- Small Business Set-aside (SBSA)
- IEWTPT I/Os - Discussing Strategy with ACC-Orlando:
 - Accelerated schedule based on prior TRIOSS work

PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

- TBD, but likely one base year plus four one-year options
- Contract Award goal allows WFF transition

Artillery & Chemical Training Contract (ACT)

Description/Summary of Program Requirements

ACT provides Life Cycle Contractor Support (LCCS) management, maintenance, and supply support for specified Army Air Defense Artillery (ADA), Field Artillery (FA), and Chemical (CM) training systems.

- Contractor will provide all maintenance and supply support required to maintain designated ACT training systems at a specified level of operational readiness
- Supports specified families of TADSS systems
- Sites in CONUS and OCONUS
- Supports Active Army, Army Reserve Component and Joint Service requirements

- Small business set-aside
