Every Soldier that deploys to a theater of combat operations trains on a PEO STRI-derived device. Some of these training devices are exhibited on the show floor:

- The **MRAP Egress Trainer** instructs Soldiers how to safely get out of a rolled over vehicle.
- The **Medical Simulation Training Center** teaches Soldiers basic combat casualty care.
- The **Route Clearance Training System** prepares Soldiers to detect and destroy IEDs.
- The **Common Driver Trainer** allows Soldiers to practice driving various military vehicles.
- The **Tactical Digital Hologram** aids in mission planning by displaying a 3D image of the battlefield.
